



KENT SCHOOLS' TRACK & FIELD CHAMPIONSHIP 2023

Saturday 3rd June 2023

The timetable for the Kent Schools' Track & Field Championships has finally been released this morning and is attached. The competition is to take place a week from today, Saturday 10th June 2023, at Medway Park, Gillingham ME7 1HF.

Please read the timetable carefully – some events have qualifying heats and a final. Athletes should aim to arrive at least an hour before their first event, in order to register, familiarise themselves with the venue and warm up properly.

Please remember that each athlete needs to pay a £5 entry fee on arrival at the registration area. This goes towards the KSAA's costs in staging the championship and supporting the subsequent inter-counties schools' events.

REMINDERS

 $1 - \underline{KIT}$: Competitors should compete in their school colours or club kit. They will need to bring eight (8) safety pins to affix numbers to their vest or shirt. (*NB* – crop tops are <u>not</u> permitted.) Spikes, if worn, must be no longer than 6mm in length.

3 – <u>REPRESENTING KENT</u>: The first two in each final (Juniors and Intermediates) will be invited to represent Kent Schools at the Inter-Counties match on Saturday 17th June. Following that event, selections will be made for the English Schools' Championship on 30th June-1st July.
